The office of Veterans and Military Services will assist all eligible veterans and dependents to obtain Veterans Education Benefits while they attend Texas Southmost College. Below is a checklist of the documentation needed for VA Education Benefits.

To apply for VA Education Benefits, go to <u>https://www.va.gov/education/how-to-apply/</u>. The Certificate of Eligibility will be mailed to you once VA processes your application/claim.

If you will be changing your Program of Study or are a new student that previously used benefits at another institution, you will need to complete **VA form 22-1995/5495 and provide an updated Program of Study from Academic Advising.

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Texas Hazlewood Act Exemption

Documentation Checklist

The Hazlewood Act is a State of Texas benefit that provides qualified Veterans, spouses, and dependent children with an education benefit of up to 150 hours of tuition exemption, including most fee charges, at public institutions of higher education in Texas. This does NOT include living expenses, books, or supply fees. Below is a checklist of the documentation needed for the Hazlewood Act Exemption.

**<u>To comply with the Federal Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) requirements<mark>, ALL</mark></u>

applicants (Veteran and dependents) must register into the Hazlewood Online Database to use the Hazlewood Exemption at <u>https://hazlewood.tvc.texas.gov/students/</u>.

NOTE: Applications and all supporting documentation must be submitted no later than the last day of class of the semester requesting the benefit, in order to be evaluated for that semester or term.

** Applicants must meet the GPA requirement of the institution's satisfactory academic progress policy in a degree or certificate program as determined by the institution's financial aid policy and, as an undergraduate student, not be considered to have attempted an excessive amount of credit hours. This requirement does not apply to the child of a MIA, KIA, or service connected deceased Veteran.
