Associate Degree Nursing Program Application Checklist

Please read the checklist carefully and initial each step once they are completed. You must include a signed COPY of this completed checklist with your application packet.

APPLICATION DEADLINES: January 15th for Summer LVN to RN students
May 25th for Fall entry
September 1st for Spring Entry

- 1. Submit an application to Texas Southmost College, *meet requirements for admission*, and **obtain a TSC ID number**. You may apply at <http://www.tsc.edu/index.php/admissions-and-records/apply-now.html> or apply in person at the Oliveira Student Services Center.
- 2. Fill out the Associate Degree Nursing Application completely.
- 3. Transcripts, only official transcripts will be accepted. You must turn in all transcripts to TSC Admission and Records for evaluation of courses, AND official transcripts for all colleges or universities attended must be turned in directly to the ADN nursing office.
- 4. Completion of all ADN Pre-requisite courses by the application deadline. BIOL 2301 Anatomy & Physiology I, BIOL 2101 Anatomy & Physiology I Lab, MATH 1342 Elementary Statistics, BIOL 2302 Anatomy & Physiology II, BIOL 2102 Anatomy & Physiology II Lab with a **minimum achievement of a “C”** in each course.
- 5. Biology pre-requisites courses must have been completed within five years prior to entering the nursing program.
- 6. A minimum college GPA of 2.5 **from all complete college courses applicable to the nursing degree** (pre-requisite and co-requisite courses).
- 7. HESI Entrance Exam completed and scores attached to the application. Passing minimum is an 80 on each individual section of the HESI A2, and 800 on the Critical Thinking exam.

- 8. A copy of your American Heart Association BLS for Health Care Provider CPR card submitted with the application packet, or understanding it will be submitted by the first day of class.
- 9. Proof of immunizations (Immunization Compliance Record form) completed and submitted with application.
**Note the Hepatitis B vaccine can take up to 6 months to complete. You must be able to have the series completed prior to the first day of class.
- 10. I am applying for the LVN to RN Bridge ADN program (summer start only)
 I am attaching my employment letter indicating at minimum 6 months of consecutive direct patient care employment.
 I am attaching a copy of my LVN unencumbered Texas Nursing License.
- 11. I have attended another Associate Degree Nursing or Bachelor Degree Nursing program and exited the program and understand I must submit a letter of good standing from the Dean or Director of the program(s) I attended.
- 12. Students must provide proof of current health insurance and maintain health insurance throughout the entirety of the ADN program. Proof of insurance must be provided by the first day of class.
- 13. Acknowledgment and completion of the Essential Physical Competencies required for nursing form and submitted with the application.
