# **How to Initiate Services**

To request a service you may call or go by the office to set up an appointment. Intake appointments for counseling or accessibility resources are usually one hour. For accessibility resources it is best to bring in your documentation during the intake appointment, Accommodations can take two to four weeks to process, depending on request.

## **Counseling Services**

- Individual therapy
- Case Management and referrals
- Anger management counseling
- Substance abuse counseling

## **Accessibility Resources**

- Extended time for tests & quizzes
- Distraction reduced testing
- Permission to audio record lectures
- Books in alternative format
- Use of assistive technology like Dragon Dictate, JAWS screen reader, ClaroRead, Scanner Pens, talking calculators, etc.
- Sign language interpreters

\*Accommodations are granted to qualified individuals on a case-by-case basis and are contingent upon documentation from a qualified professional and self report of needs.

## **DUAL ENROLLMENT**

- Students taking classes for college credit on school district property would obtain their accommodations at their high school. The high school partner will determine the accommodations based on the standards set forth by the ADAAA and Section 504 subpart E.
- Students taking classes for college credit on TSC property would self-identify with the Office of Counseling and Student Accessibility Resources, provide appropriate and relevant documentation of a disability, and go through an intake appointment.
