

Quizizz-Free Quizzes for Every Student


Quizizz provides free quizzing tools for instructors and students. These can be used for pre/post assessments to check for understanding or by students as self-assessments.

Creating a Quizizz Account

- **You must create a Quizizz account before you can begin creating your own quizzes.
- **Students can join a Quizizz game without create an account.

To create a Quizizz account, go to https://quizizz.com.

1. Use the **Sign-Up** button to create a Quizizz account using your preferred email.



2. Select how you are using Quizizz.

Once you have completed registration, you will be directed to the Admin panel.

Creating a New Quiz

You can create a new quiz in the Admin panel.

- 1. Click the **Create New Quiz** button located in the upper-left hand corner.
- 2. Enter a quiz name. Optional: Add a quiz image.



- 3. Click Save to continue.
- 4. To create a new question, click the **Create a New Question** button.




The Quizizz question editor will open.



5. Enter the question and answers in the text fields provided. Images can be provided as answers instead of text.

There is an option for single answer or multiple answers.



There is also an option for time limit per question.

- 6. Use the green checkmarks to select the correct answers.
- 7. Click **Save** to continue adding more questions.
- 8. Repeats steps 4-7 to create the rest of your quiz. When complete, click **Finish Quiz** and select the details your quiz details.

Importing Existing Questions into a Quiz


You can import existing questions into a quiz.

1. Click the search from existing questions button.




2. Enter a search term.

There are options to include duplicate questions and only search your own quizzes.





3. Use the quiz preview area to review questions. Click the **+Add** button to add the question to your quiz.



4. You can continue adding more questions or return to your quiz using the arrow in the upper-right hand corner.



5. Repeat steps 1-4 to complete the rest of your quiz. When complete, click **Finish Quiz** and select your quiz details.


Hosting a Quizizz Game

Use the Home a game or play solo buttons to start your session.

Live Game: Requires at least two participants. Use this option to engage your students in real-time.

Homework Game: Lets you set a date a time the students should complete the quiz by.

Solo game: is a practice run of your quiz.



- 1. There are some settings you can adjust before beginning your game. See the next page for more information.
- 2. Click the **Proceed** button to start a quiz game.





Quizizz Play Settings

Before hosting a Quizizz session, you can edit the settings of the quiz. Below is a listing of the settings. You can toggle these settings on/off.

Question Settings

- Require login: requires students to have an account.
- **Shuffle questions:** will randomize the questions for students.
- **Shuffle answers:** will randomize the answers for students.
- Show answers: will show the answers after each question.
- Show quiz review: will let students see all the questions after the game.

Game Settings

- **Show leaderboard:** shows leaderboard on student screens.
- Question timer: gives more points for faster responses.
- **Show memes:** shows funny pictures in-between questions.
- Play music: plays music on student devices.

Select Meme Set

• Allows you to pick a meme set to display in-between questions. These can be set to random, featured memes, or a meme sets you created.

Other Features in Quizzes

There are other features in Quizizz that this handout will not cover in-depth.

Quizizz Meme Sets

The Memes set area allows you to create your own memes to input into your quiz games. You can access this area from the **Memes** link in your Admin panel.

Reports

The reports area will generate reports of your students' activity within your quizzes.

Collections

The collections area lets you categorize your favorite quizzes. This can be used to separate quizzes based on class, topics, weeks, etc.

Profile, Settings, Logout

This area can be used to update your profile information, password, user name, etc. I won't bore you with the details.
