- Actions that make it difficult for instructors and others to deliver their presentations.
- Behaviors include, but not limited to, talking out of turn, interrupting, sleeping, listening to music, or text messaging.
- Behavior that intends to or results in the theft or destruction of property.
- The sale, possession, distribution of any illegal controlled substance.
- Cigarettes, or any tobacco products, alcohol, non-prescribed drugs, weapons and pornographic material are prohibited from campus.
