Goal: Increase state licensure exams passage rate

Vision 2023 Goal: Foster Student Success

Criteria: Increase the state licensure exam passage rates to above 80%.

Threshold of Acceptability: Expected to be greater than the baseline and/or previous year's

results, depending on which is greater

Results:

Texas Southmost College (TSC) regularly tracks the percentage of those student who pass a licensure exam through the Office of Institutional Research. This data tracking takes place as part of the TSC's Vision 2023 Strategic Plan. Institutional data for this outcome was derived from the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB), Data Resources for the Legislative Budget Board (LBB) Performance Measures (2018 – 2024 reports) for Texas Community, Technical, and State Colleges. TSC was able to achieve the 80% target rate in three of the eight years presented. Its' lowest passing percentage 76.5% was observed during the COVID pandemic year (FY 2020).
