



ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

**TEXAS SOUTHMOST COLLEGE
ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE PROGRAMS AND
ASSOCIATE OF ARTS IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE**

TO

SOUTH TEXAS COLLEGE

BACHELOR OF APPLIED TECHNOLOGY AND BACHELOR OF APPLIED SCIENCE PROGRAMS

This articulation agreement is designed to facilitate the transfer of students from Texas Southmost College (TSC) Associate of Applied Science degree programs and the Associate of Arts (AA) degree in Criminal Justice to the South Texas College (STC) Bachelor of Applied Technology and Bachelor of Applied Science degree programs. Both TSC and STC are accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC).

Both institutions enter into this agreement under the following provisions:

1. Purpose

This agreement from the Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degrees and the Associate of Arts (AA) degree in Criminal Justice at TSC to the Bachelor of Applied Technology (BAT) and Bachelor of Applied Science (BAS) degrees at STC is designed to provide students a smoother transfer path to a bachelor's degree from the TSC degree programs. Please see Appendix I which shows which TSC AAS/AA degrees are aligned to which STC BAT/BAS degrees. All degrees are approved by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board to meet specific career skill requirements through college credit programs. This collaboration is distinctive in several ways.

- TSC students will be able to obtain a bachelor's degree from a partnering Texas community college.
- TSC degrees will transfer as per the attached degree transfer plans (see Appendix II) and fulfill lower-level requirements for the bachelor's degree. TSC transfer students will need to complete all core curriculum component areas in order to be core complete.
- TSC students will complete the bachelor's degree requirements via online delivery and for some degrees, using the competency-based education model, which focuses on proficiency.
- STC will only accept credits from transferring TSC students from courses taken within the seven years prior to their enrollment at STC.

2. Admission Requirements

STC's BAT and BAS degrees are selective programs with specific transfer admissions requirements. TSC students who have completed an AAS or AA in Criminal Justice at TSC who wish to matriculate into the BAT or BAS programs must meet the following admissions

requirements (also found in the STC Catalog, which can be accessed through the following link: <http://catalog.southtexascollege.edu/baccalaureate-degrees>):

- a. Demonstrate proficiency in state mandated general knowledge content through approved means, i.e. Texas Success Initiatives (TSI), with program specific exemptions accepted.
- b. TSC students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or provide evidence of extenuating circumstances to the STC Dean for Math, Science and Bachelors Programs.
 - i. Provisional Acceptance: TSC students who have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.4 may be granted Provisional Acceptance by the STC Dean for Math, Science and Bachelors Program upon completion of a personal interview with the prospective applicant.

3. Transfer of Coursework

Courses completed as part of an AAS or AA in Criminal Justice degree programs at TSC are transferable to STC and will satisfy lower division requirements of the BAT and BAS baccalaureate degree, please see Appendix II for further information regarding the transferability and applicability of TSC courses.

- a. In accordance with Sec 61.822 of the Texas Education Code, a student who successfully completes courses in the TSC core curriculum will receive academic credit at STC for each of the courses transferred and they will be applied to the same core component area.
- b. For the BAT in Computer and Information Technology: As of Spring 2019, courses in the AAS Field of Study will be applied to satisfy 45 of the required 48 semester credit hours of lower-level technical support areas.
- c. The department chairperson of the Computer and Information Technology baccalaureate degree program has agreed to waive the current required technical support courses for transferring TSC students.
- d. All courses considered for transfer must be completed with a “C” or better for acceptance into any of STC’s baccalaureate degrees.
- e. TSC students will have the option of completing the 42-credit hour core curriculum at TSC before matriculating into the BAT or BAS program at STC, or by co-enrolling at both STC and TSC while beginning the STC upper level courses. STC and TSC will work together to establish a Financial Aid Consortium Agreement to allow students to use their financial aid at both institutions.

4. Academic Advising

All TSC students intending to transfer to STC are strongly encouraged to work closely with the STC Academic Coach well ahead of transferring to ensure the timely completion of all baccalaureate degree requirements. STC will provide a contact person who is knowledgeable about the BAT and BAS degrees and can share accurate and complete information with TSC students, faculty and advisors. It is the responsibility of each student to be knowledgeable of all degree requirements and the provisions of this agreement.

5. Baccalaureate Programs

This collaboration between STC and TSC will provide students interested in the baccalaureate programs additional opportunities to learn more about STC through special mailings, scheduled visits with STC representatives, and an invitation for STC to participate in TSC’s Transfer Fairs, if applicable.

6. Transfer Guide (Appendix II)

The Transfer Guide (Appendix II) lists the STC courses that TSC students must complete to earn the BAT and BAS degrees, specific to their AAS degree or AA degree in Criminal Justice.

7. Articulation Agreement Review

This articulation agreement will be reviewed annually by both institutions to ensure the ease of transfer of students from TSC to STC. Any change(s) to this agreement must be agreed upon in writing by both parties.

8. TSC grants permission to STC, and STC grants permission to TSC to use, display, reproduce and publish each other's trademarks and logos as an institutional partner on the TSC and STC websites, cobranded web portals, in-print publications, and joint press releases. Each institution will have the opportunity to review publications before they are published.

9. TSC and STC will cooperate to ensure that all federal regulations related to the Americans with Disabilities Act, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, and Title IX are met and will communicate any issues regarding behavioral and/or conduct issues that may impact successful completion of the program.

10. STC will report annually on the enrollment and academic progress of TSC transfer students in the BAT and BAS degree program. The report would include the number of students and a breakdown of GPA for TSC students as compared to all other transfer students. This information shall be furnished within the provisions of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act. The data may be incorporated into the TSC institutional effectiveness studies.

11. STC and TSC are equal opportunity institutions, and shall not discriminate unlawfully against any student, applicant, or employee, nor shall it deny the benefits provided its own degree seeking student to any other person on the basis of race, color, national origin, ancestry, disability, marital status, age or gender.


