TEXAS SOUTHMOST COLLEGE
Memorandum of Understanding**

Introduction

Texas Southmost College wishes to partner with transfer institutions interested in ensuring students take the maximum courses possible prior to transfer with all college-level courses earned counting toward their intended field of study or major at the four-year college or university. This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) formally recognizes that Texas Southmost College herein after referred to as TSC and Texas A&M University-Kingsville herein referred to as TAMUK, are proactive educational partners, committed to providing greater education opportunities and services for students transferring between institutions. Texas Southmost College, located in Brownsville, TX, is a public, two-year college accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges and Texas A&M University-Kingsville, located in Kingsville, TX, is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. This commitment strongly supports the concept of seamless transfer that embraces the principle that transfer students should not be required to repeat courses already successfully completed. Both institutions share a Texas common interest in expanding the availability of quality higher education. Each institution, furthermore, is dedicated to serving students from all walks of life, regardless of race, ethnicity, religion, sex, disability, color, age, marital status, national origin or other non-merit factors.

Purpose

The purpose of this MOU is to formalize a partnership to assist students to achieve both associate and baccalaureate completion. This agreement enables TSC students who transfer to TAMUK to have the college-level credits earned apply, to the greatest extent possible, toward their intended field of study or major, resulting in degree completion and successful employment.

Transfer Equivalency Guides (Program Maps)

In collaboration with the TSC, TAMUK will provide appropriate transfer equivalency guides (program maps) to identify all freshman and sophomore level courses required for specific baccalaureate degrees. This will ensure maximum transferability of courses with the intent that courses taken at TSC will count toward degree requirements. Where applicable, TAMUK will encourage students to complete an Associate degree at TSC before transfer. If the program map does not meet Associate Degree requirements, both partners agree that the student should transfer and achieve the Associate degree through reverse transfer.

At TAMUK, the maximum number of transfer credits that will be applied toward a baccalaureate degree varies by program. Where program maps include greater than 60 credit hours, the student is encouraged to earn the maximum allowable hours before transfer.

TAMUK will notify TSC of any changes to degree requirements annually and vice versa for TSC to TAMUK.

Bridge to Transfer

By the completion of 30 college-level hours, TSC students will declare the college/university to which they intend to transfer. Upon receiving notice of intent to transfer, TAMUK's and the TSC's advising/mentoring teams will work together to actively engage the student to support successful completion of the Program Map courses and prepare them to transfer.

The TSC and TAMUK agree to provide direct links between their institutional web sites indicating the existence of this Agreement. Official lists of program maps (AA, AAT, AS, and AAS) approved by both the TSC and TAMUK will be made available at both institutions.

Transfer of Courses

Core Curriculum:

Completion of the TSC Core Curriculum will transfer as a block and will satisfy the Texas 42-hour core general education requirements at TAMUK. If any courses are preferred or required for specific baccalaureate degrees, the courses will be indicated as such in the program maps. In cases where there is not an equivalent course at TAMUK, the course will be transferred as an elective and applied to the relevant core requirement.

Workforce Courses:

Workforce education courses (WECM) are not automatically accepted by TAMUK. It will be up to the department to accept the course along with a substantiation form (which is on the website).

Transfer Admissions Requirements

Upon completion of a program map, TSC students will go through TAMUK's transfer process and therefore must meet all applicable requirements and deadlines pertaining to application for admission, orientation and registration, and payment of tuition and fees. They will abide by the policies and procedures, along with any revisions thereof that apply to all students from that institution. TAMUK will apply the program map applicable in the year the student enters the TSC in compliance with Texas Administrative Code Title 19, Part 1, Subchapter B, Rule 4.25.g.

Students with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 (or minimum 2.5 GPA for the College of Engineering) and any additional admission requirements entering under the terms of this agreement are guaranteed admission into the university. Students who have completed the program map requirements with the minimum cumulative GPA required for entry into the intended field of study or major plus any other admission requirements will be accepted into the program, subject to capacity availability.

TEXAS SOUTHMOST COLLEGE Associate in Applied Science (AAS) Degree

The Associate in Applied Science (AAS) Degree represents the attainment of depth of technical competency in identified occupational areas. Students transferring an AAS degree to TAMUK will have achieved competency in many areas generally considered to be upper division. However, some courses in the area of general education may still need to be earned. TAMUK

will provide program maps that maximize the AAS course requirements and will bridge the two institutions as the student completes the Program Map courses and prepares for transfer.

Provision for Student Financial Assistance

TSC and TAMUK understand that all rules and regulations regarding the administration of Federal Title IV Student Financial Aid apply to students who may wish to attend both institutions simultaneously. A consortium agreement must be obtained by the student from the Financial Aid Office of their primary “home” institution and submitted to the Financial Aid Office of the “host” institution for completion.

Provision for Campus Visits/Transfer Fairs

TSC will provide to TAMUK opportunities to recruit students. Opportunities include but are not limited to: transfer fairs, campus visits, events posting, and university-specific fairs. Information sessions can be offered and Advisors will be available on campus, or by alternate means, by appointment for transfer planning. TAMUK will coordinate all such efforts with Academic Advising at TSC.

Any marketing or advising materials developed by TAMUK will adhere to the terms of this MOU.

Reverse Transfer

“Reverse Transfer” allows students to transfer course work from TAMUK back to the TSC to complete requirements for the associate degree. This program is specifically designed to allow students to receive the advantage of receiving an associate’s degree when they leave the TSC prior to degree completion. TAMUK and the TSC will develop a reverse transfer process to provide students with the opportunity to complete the associate’s degree while working on their TAMUK bachelor’s degree. Student records will be exchanged between TAMUK and the TSC for this purpose, strictly adhering to all privacy regulations and ensuring compliance with House Bill 3025.

Any student who transfers from a two-year degree awarding institution to another Texas public college or university, has completed 25% of the Associate degree (usually 15 college-level credit hours) and has subsequently earned credits at the transfer institution may qualify for an Associate’s Degree at the two-year institution.

Earned hours must include the courses required by the Texas Higher Education Act as set forth in Subchapter F, sections 51.301 and 51.302 (six [6] semester hours in U.S./Texas government and six [6] hours in U.S./Texas history).

Longevity of the Agreement

This agreement will commence with the start of the Fall semester 2020 for a period of three years. It will terminate with the start of the Fall semester 2023 unless it is renewed.

The agreement may be terminated by either institution by submitting written notice of the intent to terminate.

In the event this agreement is terminated, both parties agree to make every effort to protect individual students who are already part of the program.

This framework of cooperation is agreed to between TSC and TAMUK.

Although following a pathway does not guarantee admission to Texas A&M-Kingsville, it gives you a clear roadmap to prepare for your major and be well positioned to graduate on time.

Candidates for a bachelor's degree must have a minimum of 25% of total semester credit hours (SCH) required for the degree completed in residence at Texas A&M-Kingsville. Twenty-four of the last 30 SCH must be taken at Texas A&M-Kingsville.

A major when specified as a degree requirement shall consist of a minimum of 24 SCH in one subject, 6 of which must be taken at Texas A&M-Kingsville. In English, the required freshman courses may not count as part of this amount.

A minor shall consist of a minimum of 18 SCH in a subject closely related to the major. In English, the required freshman courses may not count as part of this amount. At least 50% of the work offered in the major field must be advanced, and at least 6 SCH of advanced work must be offered in the minor field.

Although following a pathway does not guarantee admission to Texas A&M-Kingsville, it gives you a clear roadmap to prepare for your major and be well positioned to graduate on time.

Candidates for a bachelor's degree must have a minimum of 25% of total semester credit hours (SCH) required for the degree completed in residence at Texas A&M-Kingsville. Twenty-four of the last 30 SCH must be taken at Texas A&M-Kingsville.

A major when specified as a degree requirement shall consist of a minimum of 24 SCH in one subject, 6 of which must be taken at Texas A&M-Kingsville. In English, the required freshman courses may not count as part of this amount.

A minor shall consist of a minimum of 18 SCH in a subject closely related to the major. In English, the required freshman courses may not count as part of this amount. At least 50% of the work offered in the major field must be advanced, and at least 6 SCH of advanced work must be offered in the minor field.
