Tuition, In-District	\$ 50.00	Per semester credit hour. For students who establish residency with-in the taxing district of the college.
Tuition, Out-of-District	\$ 75.00	Per semester credit hour. For students who establish residency with-in the State of Texas, or qualify for this rate per Texas Statutes.
Tuition, Out-of-State and International	\$ 125.00	Per semester credit hour. For students who live outside of the State of Texas.
Tuition for Repeated Hours	\$ 50.00	Per semester credit hour. For those students attempting a course for the third attempt and any additional attempts. (Three-peat Rule).
Tuition for Excessive Developmental Hours	\$ 50.00	Additional charge per semester credit hour. For students taking an excess of 18 hours of Developmental Education courses and an excess of 27 hours for Developmental Education ESOL courses.
REFUNDABLE FEES		
Required Fees - All Students		
Building Use Fee	\$ 35.00	Per semester credit hour. This fee is charged to cover the cost of maintaining, improving and equipping the campus facilities.
General Use Fee	\$ 32.00	Per semester credit hour. This fee is charged to cover the costs of transcripts, graduation, grounds improvements, technology centers, campus security and parking control.
Institutional Support	\$10.00	Per semester credit hour. This fee is charged for the support and maintenance of instructional labs, digital library, Centers for Academic Excellence and other instructional support expenses.
Student Services Fee	\$ 50.00	Per semester. This fee defrays the cost of cultural programs, intramural sports, student club activities, and other student programs.
Student Recreation Fee	\$ 75.00	Per semester. Pro-rated to \$39.50 for each summer session. This fee pays for financing, constructing, operating, maintaining, renovating, and improving the wellness, recreational and fitness complex.

Lab Fee	\$34.00	Charged per lab hour, clinical hour, and Health Professions practicum hour. to courses that have any of these components as identified within the student course catalog.
Non-Course Based Option Fee	\$ 80.00	Per Course
Electronic Education Fee	\$18.00	Per semester credit hour.

Add/Drop Fee	\$ 5.00	Per course, per semester fee is assessed to defray the costs of adding and dropping courses during the add/drop periods. If there is a even exchange of classes, the fee will not be charged.
Audit Fee	\$ 50.00	Per semester credit hour audited, if the instructor permits auditing a course. No other services are provided and no other fees are charged except any applicable textbook costs (digital)
Returned Check Charge	\$ 25.00	Assessed to students for each returned check. The institution may refuse to accept checks from students who have previously had a check returned.
