The 80-hour Industrial Insulation hands-on training program provides entry-level tradesman training on the proper methods and procedures to identify, inspect, removal/replacement and fabrication of mechanical insulation in industrial environments. It covers the proper use of tools and safety practices required to work in the industry. The five groups of insulation types are covered in this course. These include cellular, fibrous, flake, granular and reflective. The students are taught to cut, fit, and attach the insulation materials according to industry standards. These skills will help the graduate begin a career in many different areas of the industry such as refineries, manufacturing facilities, aerospace, and other related fields.
