Dr. Figueroa reported that TSC was awarded \$7,727,922 through the American Recovery Act (ARP) Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Student Portion — CARES 3. Through this funding, TSC will disburse two \$500 payments to students through their individually requested method. The funding will be dispersed to all students enrolled in credit courses during the current fall semester, with the exception of dual credit students.
