- Applicants must meet each of the following qualifications:
  - Have applied for Financial Aid, and completed ALL Financial Aid paperwork;
  - Be in good academic standing (cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher);
  - Be enrolled for six or more credit hours which are eligible for Financial Aid;
  - Have a zero balance with TSC for prior semesters;
  - Not on Financial Aid suspension.
- If you do not meet these qualifications, a Payment Plan is available on MyTSC Online/Student Account Service.
- Apply only after your registration is complete.
- The Emergency Tuition Loan protects your classes, as long as the Emergency Tuition Loan amount is larger than your tuition charges. If you decide later not to attend, you must drop your classes with the Office of Admissions & Records or through MyTSC online. Charges will apply if you drop on or after the first day of class.
- Emergency Tuition Loans are for tuition and mandatory fees only (not books, supplies, etc.). You must pay any non-covered items before the application is processed. Deadline is **January 15, 2021**, no later than 12:00 p.m.
- Emergency Tuition Loans are due in full on **February 5, 2021**.
- The maximum loan amount will not exceed \$500.
- The student is responsible for payment of any unpaid balance.
