This short-term workforce program is designed for anyone who is interested in a pursuing a career as a plumbing technician. This program will provide the skills to identify and select common plumbing materials and equipment, perform mathematical calculations applicable to the plumbing trade, and operate hand and power tools safety. A student will learn design and layout, assembly and installation of various plumbing systems, and general safety. Upon completion of both courses, students will have the opportunity to earn an Occupational Skill Award, an OSHA 10-hour certification, and apply for the apprentice license with the State of Texas.
